POSITION:

Assistant Professor or Artist in Residence in Video Writing/Film Production. Nine-month appointment starting August 18th, 2008. Salary: \$40,000.

QUALIFICATIONS:

MFA degree or significant professional experience in Video Writing, Film Production and Documentaries. Teaching experience desirable.

DUTIES:

Teaching duties include courses from a group including Intro to Video Writing, Intro to Screenwriting, Intro to Cinema Techniques and Documentary Production.

Undergraduate advising and other administrative duties as needed.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Department of Film, Theatre, and Communication Arts currently has twelve full-time and several part-time faculty serving approximately 450 undergraduate and 40 graduate students. For the BA, our students study under one of three curriculum track options (Film Arts, Theatre Arts, and Communication Arts) with the majority in Film Arts. The Department also offers an MFA degree in Film Production, Theatre Performance and Design. Additionally, we are associated with two graduate interdisciplinary programs: MFA in Creative Writing (Screenwriting, Playwriting, Fiction, Poetry and Creative non-fiction) and an MA in Arts Administration, as well as the Nims Studio Center which services major feature film productions shot in the New Orleans area. The Department is fully accredited by the National Association of Schools of Theatre. We have a strong commitment to production supported by a thorough understanding of the artistic process, including history, theory and criticism.
